

4. To consider whether it would be appropriate to place a dog bin on LVMRG

A resident has stated that there used to be a dog poo bin on LVMRG and that it has been removed and not replaced. The Trustee have never owned a dog poo bin or arranged for it to be emptied. Our lengthsman recalls that several years ago there was one near to the gate at the beginning of what is now the overflow car park but that it has not been there for many years. SRBC say that they have not removed any bin recently but cannot speak for the past.

To have a bin installed and emptied by SRBC will cost £300 one off installation plus £436.80 per year to empty weekly.

There is a litter/dog bin situated within 50 yards of the previous location, at the entrance to Victory Road on School Lane and another across the road. I suspect but have no evidence to prove; that SRBC may have removed the previous bin some years ago when those on School Lane were installed on the basis that they were sufficiently close to the recreation ground for dog walker use.

It was resolved that due to the nearness of existing bins it was not appropriate to spend the monies outlined above and that no further installation was required.
